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THE GOAL OF THE PROGRAMME

The objectives of the Business Analysis Master's Program are for a student to:

- ✓ Shape the skills of systematic and in-depth analysis of existing business processes to achieve business goals, which will enable to determine the business vision using analytical tools;
- ✓ Establish and develop skills in identifying business needs, strategic goals and objectives, and evaluation of relevant software and technology provision;
- ✓ Develop the necessary skills for obtaining information, analyzing, planning relevant changes and preparing effective business models within the frames of management methodology;
- ✓ Learn the process of identifying business requirements. Also, through informational, digital and technological comparison, develop the ability to form and/or transform the desired business model;
- ✓ Develop verbal and written communication skills with a variety of stakeholders, including the ability to mediate communication with information technology staff.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

The learning outcomes of the Business Analysis Master's Program:

- ✓ Deeply perceives the mission of the business, evaluates and analyzes the strategic goals and objectives of the business, determines compliance with the main mission of the organization and prepares recommendations for improvement with data-based decisions;
- ✓ Collaborates with stakeholders at different levels of the organization to identify their needs and expectations;
- ✓ Independently uses the latest technologies of business analysis to collect information and conduct thorough analysis, models and interprets the data;
- ✓ Creates clear and concise documentation of business analysis and requirements, technical specifications, and communicates effectively with the stakeholders;
- ✓ Using various business diagrams, deeply analyzes and/or creates business processes, optimizes them;
- ✓ Independently researches and develops new approaches in the field of business analysis, makes optimal and original decisions, plans and implements short-term and long-term objectives;
- ✓ Discusses and compares best practices of business analysis and guidelines for adapting to different project types;
- ✓ Ensures data security by adhering to professional ethics and academic integrity;
- ✓ Coordinates the working group, determines the necessary directions for further development of oneself and the team members, works in a coordinated manner in a multidisciplinary environment.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Enrollment Conditions

A person with a bachelor's degree or an equivalent academic degree is eligible to study for a master's degree program, who will be enrolled in the Unified Master's Examination and the Georgian National University SEU as a result of passing a specialty and passing an entrance exam in a foreign language (English). A candidate who presents a certificate of foreign language proficiency at B2 level is exempted from foreign language testing, as well as a candidate who has completed a bachelor's or master's degree in the relevant language.

Enrollment Without Passing the Unified Master's Examination

- ✓ For master's degree candidates who have received a document certifying the academic degree of higher education in a foreign country;
- ✓ For foreign citizens (except for students participating in a joint higher education program) who are studying / have studied and received credit / qualifications in a master's degree at a higher education institution recognized in a foreign country in accordance with the legislation of that country;
- ✓ For Georgian citizens (except for students participating in the joint higher education program and students participating in the exchange education program) who live / have lived, studied / studied and received credits / qualifications recognized abroad in accordance with the legislation of this country for a period determined by the Ministry of Education and Science In a master's degree at an educational institution;
- ✓ For Master's degree candidates who have been admitted to a higher education institution without the Unified National Examinations;
- ✓ For foreign citizens who have obtained the right to continue their education in a higher education institution of Georgia before the enactment of the Law of Georgia on Higher Education and have a document certifying higher education recognized by the state in Georgia;
- ✓ The Higher Educational Institution is obliged to confirm that the persons, wishing to obtain the right to study, possess the language of instruction of the chosen educational program at least B2 level.

PROGRAMME ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Enrollment by Mobility

Admission of students from other higher education institutions / programs to the Business Analysis master's program through mobility is carried out in accordance with the rules established by the order N 10 / N of the Minister of Education and Science of February 4, 2010.

A person whose enrollment in a higher education institution has been carried out in accordance with the rules established by law and is a student of the institution wishing to register for mobility on the electronic portal of the Education Management Information System has the right to mobility.

The right to mobility is also granted to a person whose student status has been suspended at the time of registration on the electronic portal or to a person whose status has been terminated within 12 months of the termination of the status.

Enrollment in the master's educational program or enrollment by transfer from a recognized higher education institution abroad is carried out on the basis of the order of the Minister of Education and Science of Georgia. Based on the decision / consent of the Ministry of Education and Science of Georgia.

PROGRAMME EMPLOYMENT FIELD

The Master's program in Business Analysis combines technical and managerial components, therefore graduates are given particularly broad opportunities for professional advancement. The obtained theoretical and practical knowledge will allow the graduates to be employed in organizations of various profiles, be it public or private sector, on the following positions: middle business analyst, system analyst, product owner/manager, quality assurance analyst, digital transformation analyst, data analyst, etc.
